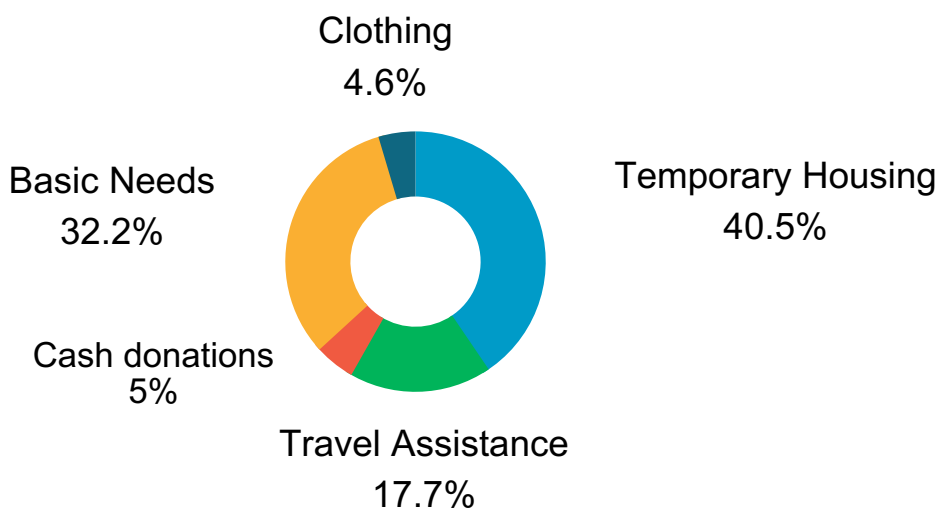


PRIORITY NEEDS OF DISPLACED UKRAINIANS



Out of 158,677 displaced Ukrainians who have arrived under special immigration measures in Canada, more than 19,000 individuals have been assisted.



TEMPORARY HOUSING
provided to 531 individuals and 402 families.

BASIC NEEDS
provided through 10,500 gift cards.

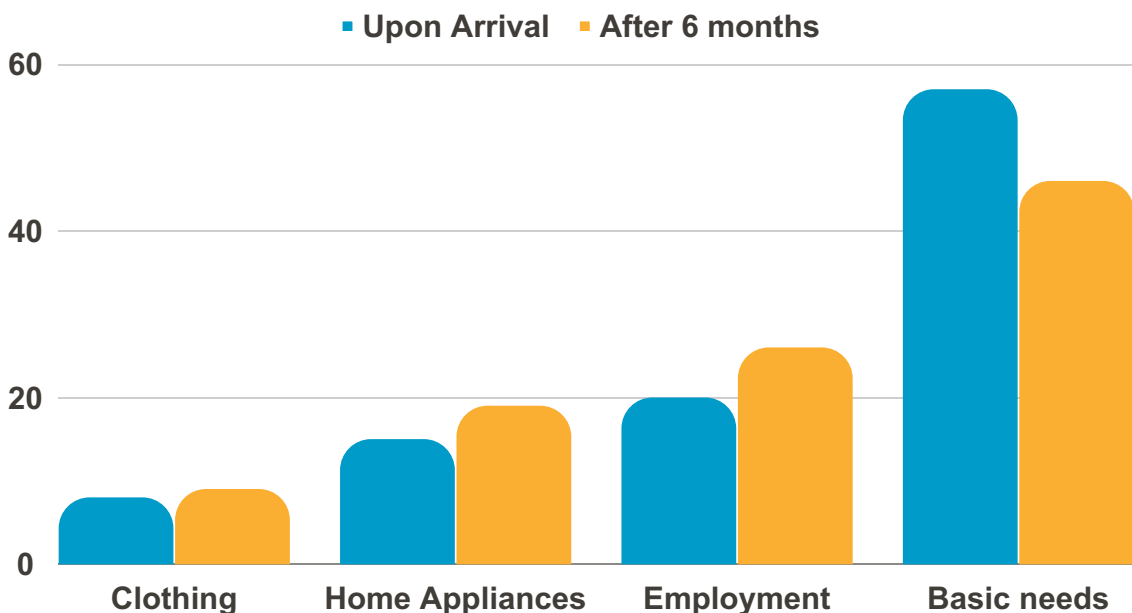
TRAVEL ASSISTANCE
