


PRIORITY NEEDS OF DISPLACED UKRAINIANS



Out of 158,677 displaced Ukrainians who have arrived under special immigration measures in Canada, more than 19,000 individuals have been assisted.



TEMPORARY HOUSING provided to 531 individuals and 402 families.

CASH DONATION


\$81,500 donated by Canadians citizens.
